A 34 year old female with a history of diabetes presents with a dimpled, isoechoic, 1 cm mass in the antrum during upper endoscopy. Clinically, the mass appeared confined to the mucosa and submucosa. (See figure 1 and figure 2).



Biopsies from the gastric mass show the following:
