Training for Day Care Professionals

Training for day care providers on the subject of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is crucial, as they may be the first professionals to notice unusual patterns of development among the children that they serve. Early identification and intervention is the key to a more positive prognosis for individuals with ASD, and day care providers are in the unique position to be able to refer “at risk” children for diagnostic assessment.

Day care providers who wish to learn more about how to handle issues that arise among children with ASD will benefit from this training. Information on learning styles, communicative deficits, sensory sensitivities, social impairment, and behavioral issues will also be covered.
