CONDITIONS WE TREAT

At our clinic, we treat every imaginable vein condition, including the following:

- Varicose veins

- Venous insufficiency
- Vein ulcerations
- Pulmonary embolism

TREATMENT OPTIONS

As part of a major academic medical center, we continually explore new ways to treat venous disease. We keep abreast of the latest innovations in vein treatment, bringing advanced treatment options, such as the use of leading-edge laser devices, to our patients. We perform the following procedures:

- Endovenous laser and radiofrequency ablation for varicose veins and venous insufficiency
- Vein excision for varicose veins
- Venous bypass for venous injuries, malformations and other blockages
- Vena cava filters to prevent pulmonary embolism
- Perforating vein treatment for venous insufficiency and ulcerations
- Sclerotherapy for varicose and spider veins
