**Policy on Interactions with Industry**

Background

The GME programs at Rush have a compelling obligation to ensure that the trainees practice in the most highly ethical manner possible, while ensuring that they have experiences that allow them to learn about the issues involved in their interactions with industry representatives at all levels.

Policy

1. Program Directors will become familiar with the various issues involved in physician interactions with industry.
2. Program Directors will incorporate discussions of these issues into their program curricula.
3. Program Directors will promulgate to faculty and residents the Rush Corporate Compliance policy with respect to “Business Gifts and Courtesies,” policy CC-0700-G12-1, and American Medical Association Opinion 8.061, “Gifts to Physicians from Industry,” and Opinion E-8.061, “Clarifying Addendum.”
