POLICY ON TRAINING PROGRAM APPLICANTS VISITING CLINICAL AREAS

All applicants to Rush training programs will be expected to review and sign a HIPAA agreement at the time of their visit to the Medical Center.

All applicants must wear a visitor badge while in clinical areas of the Medical Center. This badge will be provided by the program coordinator.

Applicants may visit clinical areas only when accompanied by a resident, faculty, or staff member of the training program to which they are applying.

Applicants may be observers only; they are not to touch or otherwise interact directly with patients.

Rush has additional policies that govern all visitors to the Operating Rooms. When applicable, these policies must be observed.
